Schedule:

Regular Class Tuesday, March 5

Dress Rehearsal: Wednesday, March 6 from 5:00-6:00pm

Performance: Thursday, March 7 at 6:00pm

DRESS REHEARSAL INSTRUCTIONS (Held at the GSU Performing Arts Center):

Enter in the back/artist's entrance.

If you are a backstage volunteer, you need to stay backstage during the dress rehearsals and the performances to help monitor the dancers. You may go out into the audience during the DRESS REHEARSALS, BUT NOT DURING THE SHOWS, to see their dances from the audience. This is a CLOSED rehearsal so only those who have signed up to help will be allowed backstage during rehearsals or the performance.

5:00-6:00 REHEARSAL

Times are estimated; we could be early or late, please be patient & flexible

PERFORMANCE DAY INSTRUCTIONS:

Enter in the back/ artist's entrance dressed and ready to go.

6pm Curtain/Show Arrival: 5:30pm

COSTUME REQUIREMENTS:

- Girls in the LIGHT BLUE classes will wear their Statesboro School of Dance class uniforms, clean pink tights, pink ballet shoes with the drawstrings tucked in and a solid colored LIGHT BLUE matching hair bow secured in with bobby pins or a barrette on top of the dancer's ballet bun. Please slick bangs and wispy curls back with gel or hairspray.
- Please wear light stage make-up as the parent sees fit (mascara, blush and lipstick).
- Please do not send any snacks, only water, with your dancer.
- Write names in all personal belongings.

This is a non-ticketed event. There will be a donation basket — all donations will be used for Statesboro School of Dance's local service project, "Faith in Motion", for the Boys and Girls Club.

We need parent volunteers for sign-up to work backstage during rehearsals and the show. You can sign up at the studio. For security reasons, your name must be on the backstage list to be admitted backstage.
