CLOSED DRESS REHEARSAL INSTRUCTIONS (Held at Connection Church):

We need parent volunteers for sign-up to work backstage during rehearsals and the show. To sign up, please text Ms. Shay at 912.536.4209 or email her at statesboroschoolofdance@yahoo.com. For security reasons, your name must be on the backstage list to be admitted backstage.

Enter in the rear door by the large parking lot. Only backstage volunteers will be allowed backstage. **If you are a backstage volunteer**, you need to stay backstage during the dress rehearsals and the performances to help monitor the dancers. You may go out into the audience DURING THE DRESS REHEARSALS, BUT NOT DURING THE SHOWS, to see their dances from the audience.

PERFORMANCE DAY INSTRUCTIONS (at Connection Church):

Enter in the rear door by the large parking lot dressed ready to go. Approximate Showtime is 2 hours.

Show Arrive: 9:15am | Performance starts at 10am AND

1:15pm for self-stretch and warm-ups | Performance starts at 2pm

Please pick up your child by signing them out at the check-in table after the show is over.

COSTUME REQUIREMENTS:

Party Children dancers should wear the following stage make-up: False eye lashes, foundation, powder, mascara, blush, red lipstick, brown eye shadows and eye liner and rhinestone earrings if ears are pierced.

Party Boys: Hair should be in a high bun or French braids pinned under so their hat will fit, slicked back with no bangs or wispy curls. Parents provide nude camisole leotard (girls only), white undershirt tank (boys only), black tights, and black snug-fitting ballet or jazz shoes (strings tucked in).

Party Girls: Hair needs to be pulled half up and the other half down and curled. Parents provide nude camisole leotard, pink tights, and pink snug-fitting leather ballet shoes with ribbons (strings tucked in).

Party Child rental costumes will be labeled with each child's name and in the dressing rooms.

THERE IS NO EATING, DRINKING, SPRAYING PERFUME ON, PAINTING OF NAILS, OR THE WEARING OF BODY LOTIONS OR SITTING IN THE RENTAL COSTUMES! If costumes are damaged due to mistreatment, the dancer will be charged a replacement/repair fee for the costume(s).

You may bring snacks (no peanut products) and water for your child to consume before or after they wear their costume. Write names in all personal belongings.
