CLOSED DRESS REHEARSAL INSTRUCTIONS (at the GSU PAC):

We need parent volunteers for sign-up to work backstage during rehearsals and the show. To sign up, please text Ms. Shay at 912.536.4209 or email her at statesboroschoolofdance@yahoo.com. For security reasons, your name must be on the backstage list to be admitted backstage.

Enter in the back/artist's entrance. Only backstage volunteers will be allowed backstage. **If you are a backstage volunteer**, you need to stay backstage during the dress rehearsals and the performances to help monitor the dancers. You may go out into the audience DURING THE DRESS REHEARSALS, BUT NOT DURING THE SHOWS, to see their dances from the audience.

PERFORMANCE DAY INSTRUCTIONS (at the GSU PAC):

Enter in the back/artist's entrance dressed and ready to go. Approximate showtime is 2 hours.

Show Arrival: 12:15pm | Performance starts at 1pm

Please pick up your child by signing them out at the check-in table after the show is over.

COSTUME REQUIREMENTS:

Girls should wear light stage make-up as the parent sees fit: mascara, blush, lipstick.

Hair should be in a high bun with no bangs or wispy curls.

Parents provide nude camisole leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes (tuck strings into ballet shoes).

Mouse rental costumes will be labeled with each child's name and in the dressing rooms.

THERE IS NO EATING, DRINKING, SPRAYING PERFUME ON, PAINTING OF NAILS, OR THE WEARING OF BODY LOTIONS OR SITTING IN THE RENTAL COSTUMES! If costumes are damaged due to mistreatment, the dancer will be charged a replacement/repair fee for the costume(s).

You may bring snacks (no peanut products) and water for your child to consume before or after they wear their costume. Write names in all personal belongings.
