Dress rehearsal: Wednesday, March 9 from 6:00-8:30pm

Performance: Thursday, March 10 at 6pm

CLOSED DRESS REHEARSAL INSTRUCTIONS (Held at the GSU Performing Arts Center):

We need parent volunteers for sign-up to work backstage during rehearsals and the show. To sign up, please text Ms. Shay at 912.536.4209 or email her at statesboroschoolofdance@yahoo.com. For security reasons, your name must be on the backstage list to be admitted backstage.

Enter in the back/artist's entrance. Only backstage volunteers will be allowed backstage. **If you are a backstage volunteer**, you need to stay backstage during the dress rehearsals and the performances to help monitor the dancers. You may go out into the audience DURING THE DRESS REHEARSALS, BUT NOT DURING THE SHOWS, to see their dances from the audience.

PERFORMANCE DAY INSTRUCTIONS:

This is a non-ticketed event with general seating. There will be a donation basket — all donations will be used for Statesboro School of Dance's local service project, "Faith in Motion", to purchase leotards, tights, shoes, and skirts for the Boys and Girls Club dancers.

Enter in the back/artist's entrance dressed and ready to go.

Show Arrival: 4:30pm for mandatory warm-ups | Curtain: 6pm

Please pick up your child by signing them out in the back Artists's entrance after the show is over.

Please **NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY** during the show. The lights could endanger our dancers.

COSTUME REQUIREMENTS:

- Girls in the BURGUNDY & BLACK class will wear their Statesboro School of Dance WHITE PRAISE DRESS (Order ASAP from Eurotard #13524 for adult sizes and 13524c for child sizes. These almost always have to be hemmed. I like the length to be at the top of their ankle bone.), clean pink tights, and pink leather ballet shoes.
- All hair pulled half up with a barrette. Please slick bangs and wispy curls back with gel/ hairspray. Please wear full stage make-up including false eyelashes and rhinestone earrings.
- You may bring healthy snacks and water for your child to consume before or after they wear their costume.
- Write names in all personal belongings.
