CLOSED DRESS REHEARSAL INSTRUCTIONS (at the GSU PAC):

We need parent volunteers for sign-up to work backstage during rehearsals and the show. To sign up, please text Ms. Shay at 912.536.4209 or email her at statesboroschoolofdance@yahoo.com. For security reasons, your name must be on the backstage list to be admitted backstage.

Enter in the back/artist's entrance. Only backstage volunteers will be allowed backstage. **If you are a backstage volunteer**, you need to stay backstage during the dress rehearsals and the performances to help monitor the dancers. You may go out into the audience DURING THE DRESS REHEARSALS, BUT NOT DURING THE SHOWS, to see their dances from the audience.

ARRIVE AT 11:45AM DRESSED AND READY TO GO IN YOUR TAP COSTUME

12:00-2:00PM: Rockette (TAP) and Teach Me How to Shimmy (JAZZ)

2:00-2:30PM: BOWS

2:30-4:30PM: PETER PAN (Mermaids BALLET dance)

Times are estimated; we could be early or late, please be patient & flexible. Please remember when picking up your child to sign them out at the check-in table.

PERFORMANCE DAY INSTRUCTIONS (at the GSU PAC):

Enter in the back/artist's entrance dressed and **ready to go in your tap costume**. Approximate showtime is 2 hours.

Show Arrival: 4:30pm | Performance starts at 5pm

Please sign in your child at the check-in table when arriving, and please sign them out when picking them up when the show is over.

COSTUME REQUIREMENTS:

Girls should wear light stage make-up as the parent sees fit: mascara, blush, lipstick. Hair should be in a high bun, slicked back with no bangs or wispy curls. All headpieces should be secured to hair with bobby pins.

TAP & JAZZ DANCES: Costumes, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, and tan tap shoes.

BALLET DANCE: Ballet costume, tan tights, and pink ballet shoes. Tuck strings on ballet shoes inside and secure with masking tape.

Any costume alterations that are needed are the responsibility of the dancer.

You may bring water for your child to consume before or after they wear their costume. You may also bring games, videos, books, etc. Write names in all personal belongings.
