Performance: Sunday, December 3

## CLOSED DRESS REHEARSAL INSTRUCTIONS (Held at the GSU Performing Arts Center):

We need parent volunteers for sign-up to work backstage during rehearsals and the show. To sign up, please text Ms. Shay at 912.536.4209 or email her at [statesboroschoolofdance@yahoo.com](mailto:statesboroschoolofdance@yahoo.com). For security reasons, your name must be on the backstage list to be admitted backstage.

Enter in the back/artist's entrance. Only backstage volunteers will be allowed backstage. If you are a backstage volunteer, you need to stay backstage during the dress rehearsals and the performances to help monitor the dancers. You may go out into the audience DURING THE DRESS REHEARSALS, BUT NOT DURING THE SHOWS, to see their dances from the audience.

5:15-6:00 BATTLE SCENE  
6:00-6:30 SNOW SCENE  
6:30-7:00 BOWS/CURTAIN CALL/FINALE  
7:00-8:30 SWEETS SCENE/FINALE AGAIN

Times are estimated; we could be early or late, please be patient & flexible. Please remember when picking up your child to sign them out at the check-in table. ## PERFORMANCE DAY INSTRUCTIONS:

Enter in back/artist's entrance. Approximate Showtime is 2 hours.

Show Arrive 11:30am for warm-ups | Performance starts at 1pm AND 4:15pm for self-stretch and warm-ups | Performance starts at 5pm

Please sign in when arriving and sign out at the check-in table after the show is over.

Please NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY during the show. The lights could endanger our dancers.

## COSTUME REQUIREMENTS:

B&B class dancers should wear the following stage make-up: False eye lashes, foundation, powder, mascara, blush, red lipstick, brown eye shadows and eye liner and rhinestone earrings if ears are pierced.

All hair needs to be in a high bun, slicked back with no bangs and parents provide a nude camisole leotard, ballet pink seamed tights and pink pointe/ballet shoes with the ribbons secured by tape or sewing during the rehearsals and shows.

The rental costumes will be labeled with each child's name and in the dressing rooms. Ask Ms. Shay about special costuming for variations.

**THERE IS NO EATING, DRINKING, SPRAYING PERFUME ON, PAINTING OF NAILS, OR THE WEARING OF BODY LOTIONS OR SITTING IN THE RENTAL COSTUMES!** If costumes are damaged due to mistreatment, the dancer will be charged a replacement/repair fee for the costume(s). Please bathe prior to and wear clear deodorant to each rehearsal and performance. Remember to hang up each costume and place all head pieces and props back where you found them.

You may bring snacks (no peanut products) and water for your child to consume before or after they wear their costume. Write names in all personal belongings.
